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2 Competition

Competition /Time schedule

Disciplines at DLRG Cup will be performed in heats, semi-finals and finals (same for female and male) depending on amount of participants.

2.1 Age groups

Classification happens in open age group.

2.2 Events

2.2.1 Single events

Each competitor takes part in the "Three individual events" classification. Maximum number of starts in single events is four per competitor. The three best results will be counted.

- Surf Race
- Board Race
- Surf Ski Race
- Oceanwoman/Oceanman (Final as eliminator-race)
- Beach Flags
- Beach Sprint

2.2.2 Team events

Only one relay per team and discipline (female and male) and one mixed team (two female and two male) is allowed to compete.

- Board-Rescue
- Rescue Tube Rescue
- Oceanwoman-/Oceanman Relay
- Beach Sprint Relay
- Ocean Lifesaver Relay

2.3 Eligibility/ Start conditions

Eligible are

- a) club teams of the DLRG
- b) Club teams of full members of the International Life Saving Federation

These teams have to consist of minimum one (1) and maximum twelve (12) competitors belonging to the age group 2003 and older. Maximum six of these twelve competitors have to be female or male participants. For each club only one team can be registered.

German Interclub teams have to confirm with registration that competitors of the team fulfil all conditions concerning § 4 of the German National Rulebook for Championships (see attachment) The organizer reserves the right to verify starting documents randomly during the competition.

Departing from § 4 of the rulebook: each competitor of the ILS Clubs must show a medical certificate and a membership confirmation.

A competitor only has start permission for one Club during a competition year. The club membership must be valid at latest at the beginning of the competition year.

All competitors younger than 18 have to show mandatorily the signed attachment for the "participation of minors" in order to get eligibility.

2.4 Classification

Pointscore occurs according to ILS Rulebook (2.6)

2.4.1 Classification of Disciplines

At DLRG Cup the first three places in the following categories are honoured:

- a) single events f/m
- b) Relays f/m

2.4.2 DLRG Cup Overall Pointscore

After finishing all disciplines the first three places in the following categories will be honoured:

- c) Classification of "three single events" f/m
For each competitor the results of his best three single events will be counted.
- d) Team Classification
For each team the four competitors with the most points in the "three single events", the points of all female and male relays including the mixed Ocean Relay will be counted.

2.4.3 Announcement of the results

2.4.4 Award Ceremony

All Award Ceremonies, described in 2.4.1, will take place during the Competition directly on the beach. They will be announced about 15 minutes before performance and will also take place in case of a winner is not on the ground. The DLRG Cup Overall standings (2.4.2) and the classification of the "three single events" are carried out during the closing ceremony.

2.5 Competition Rulebook

All competitions at DLRG Cup are carried out according to the International Rulebook of ILS (International Life Saving Federation), Competition Rule Book, 2015-2019 Edition, Revised 2017 : <https://www.ilsf.org/lifesaving-sport/rules/>

On site the manager and the judge may decide about changes concerning the carrying out of the particular competition and disciplines. Deviations from the International Rulebook are possible because of local conditions or changed conditions. This will be announced on site.

2.6 Venue

The DLRG Cup 2019 will be held in the Sport Beach Arena at beach section 1 in Warnemünde. Further information will be sent to the registered teams via mail.

2.6.1 Access venue and material storage

On the beach there will be a marked area for the competitors' equipment and/or trailer. Please use only these areas and bring boards and skis which are not in use away from the competition area. Trailers and tents have to be signed with a name and a telephone number for reachability.

Tents have to be set up safe within the marked area, please think of the weather conditions, the team is responsible for the safety. The organizer assumes no liability for loss, theft or accidental damage for the tents and equipment. To provide enough space for the trailers, boards and skis, we ask all teams to give us the necessary information in advance. Also we indicate, that it is not allowed to drive at or to the beach. Teams have to bring their trailer and equipment by hand to the storage area.

We point out that the vehicle access to the beach is generally not allowed. Only the organizer can make an exception for allowed motor vehicles, that may use the access. Infringement can lead to suspension of the competition.

Trailers have to be brought to the material storage by the teams themselves. Because of the assembly and dismantling the use of the tar road is only possible temporarily on Tuesday and on Saturday.

Following time frame is scheduled for the transport of the trailer on the tar road:

Thursday, 18.07.2019:	8.30 o'clock to ca. 10:00 o'clock and in the afternoon after release by the event management.
Saturday, 20.07.2019:	14.00 o'clock zo ca. 16.00 o'clock with the beginning of the recovery phase (building phases) only after release by the event management.
Sunday, 21.07.2019	9.00 o'clock to 12.00 o'clock

Times may change because of current and short-dated modifications. Significant are the instructions of the gatekeeper at entrance.

2.7 Equipment/ clothing

Equipment for the competition parcours and rescue tubes are provided by the organizer. An equipment pool (ski, board, paddle) is not available.

Used Material/Equipment has to accord to the Rulebook (2.5)

Competitors are permitted to use own equipment if it is scrutinized by the judge. The organizer reserves the right to brand the equipment (also the scrutinized equipment).

The participating teams are not allowed to show their own sponsors, when they are in concurrence to the event-sponsor. Therefore the participating teams have to inform the organizer about supporting advertising partners. The organizer reserves the right (until the end of competition) to forbid to start in case of non- compliance.

For safety reasons and for identifying each competitor and each assistant, who takes part in a discipline, has to wear a **pink** lycra during the competition, except the disciplines "beach flag", "beach sprint" and "beach sprint relay". Lycra vests can be acquired at the DLRG- headquarter (Materialstelle). During all competition each active participant has to wear a uniform cap, which is fixed below the chin.

Start number has to be shown visibly at both upper arms (organized by the competitors).

All teams, who have not registered their team caps yet, shall send an E-Mail which contains the registration and a description (colour, design, shading) or a photo of the team cap to: cup@dsg.dlrg.de , for orienting you find an overview of the already registered caps in the attachment. If a team changes the design of its cap, this also has to be announced.

2.8 Officials

The organizer defines the officials and invites them separately.

2.9 Doping tests

All competitors, coaches, team managers, officials and other involved persons follow the ILS Anti-Doping Policy. The event is announced to the NADA. **Doping tests** during the competition are scheduled.

2.10 Time schedule

The performing of all events are planned on Friday and Saturday in a maximum time frame from 8.00 o'clock to 18.00 o'clock and on Thursday from 13 o'clock to 18 o'clock. If not all disciplines can be realized in this time, the competition will be stopped at 18.00 o'clock with the finished finals at this time. The planned time schedule will be published before the event.

3 Registration

Registration for the 23. DLRG Cup can only be done online at <https://organet.info/>

Application is based on a procedure registration and login.

Each user registers with name, first name, mail address and password. After that, a confirmation and a link will be sent to the e-mail address. After that the registration for competition can be done. An editing of the registration is only possible after release by the organizer.

3.1 Registration period

Registration via Organet is possible between 15. and 21.06.2019

3.2 Permission procedure

For the DLRG Cup the number of competitors is limited to 360. The organizer reserves the right, to refuse starting, when the number of registered participants is achieved before deadline. Those who register afterwards, will be put on a waiting list. Successors will be approved in chronological order for cancellations or defaulters.

Successors will be informed and collected up to 14 days before the competition. Furthermore the organizer reserves the right to refuse the permission to start, when the terms of registration and payment are not fulfilled.

3.3 Announcement results

Announcement results will be published the week after registration deadline. From the date of publication it is possible to protest for three days. After that no more changes are possible.

4 General conditions

5 Costs

5.1 Entry fee

Entry fee is 08, 00 € for each individual start and 12,00 € for each relay start.

5.2 Increased Entry Fee (IEF)

An increased entry fee of additionally 50 € becomes due for each heat in the following cases:

- a) when a competitor does not appear to the DLRG-Cup
- b) when registered competitors do not appear to heat, semi-finals or finals

The ILF does not apply, when:

- a) The club cancels the participation of the athletes at the organizer (DSG) four weeks before date of competition.
- b) The club shows a medical certificate for the competitor after expiry of the four weeks mentioned in a)

- c) The club nominates a substitute for the initial competitor to maximum one day before the beginning of competition (15.00 h) or the change has been sent via mail to cup@dsg.dlrg.de
- d) When the registered competitor has cancelled his participation individual and in writing before the beginning of the competition.

The IEF has to be paid immediately on the organizers request at the competition area.

If the IEF is not paid, the organizer can refuse the continuance of the competition to all competitors from the respective club.

5.3 Participation fee evening program incl. Awards Ceremony

Each participant, competitor, accompanying persons, attendants etc. has to pay a participation fee of 12,00 € for the Closing Ceremony. This amount has to be paid together with the application. Guests may- if there is capacity – acquire a ticket during the competition days for 15,00 €. For the access to the Closing Ceremony a valid ticket is necessary, solely the ID cards does not permit to join the event.

Attention: we indicate, that it is not allowed, to take drinks of any kinds to the Closing Ceremony; Security is authorised to take it away.

6 Safety procedures

Safety has the highest priority for all participants during the competition. The instructions have to be accepted. The used equipment must be in the condition that every injury and danger is eliminated for the participants. Wetsuits should be worn at water temperatures below 16° Celsius. At water temperature below 13° wearing of wetsuits is obligatory. Furthermore we point to 2.7 – lycras.
